## Music from the UK Overseas Territories and Crown Dependencies at the conference

Whilst we cannot have social gatherings in the usual sense at the conference, we are keen to include a cultural flavour of the territories insofar as we can. We are keen that the 5-minute breaks halfway through main sessions could help with this. We invite recordings with local flavours to be submitted to the conference for this purpose. Ideally, these should last about 4 minutes (or be of a nature that taking 4-minute parts would not be problematic). These should be sent as music file attachments to <u>hello@ukotcf.org</u>. Those sending are required to make sure that there are no copyright restrictions on UKOTCF using the material in this way. Please supply the title, details of the musicians, any credits necessary and, if appropriate, a few words of context. Because information will need to be displayed during the breaks, we are not requesting video material.

However, in the longer "meal" break, there may be opportunity to play longer pieces and even some videos, appropriate to the topic of the conference. Such material should not be longer than 15 minutes and ideally shorter. Any videos should be in mp4 format. It will probably be appropriate to send by Dropbox (our preferred file transfer system), rather than attachments. Because the available time may change right up to the conference, we cannot guarantee that all material submitted will be used – but we would not ask if we thought that the chance is low. The same points about those sending being required to check the copyright situations apply.
