



Colour your own

This booklet is for you to colour your own Montserrat Biodiversity Rainbow




Blue

This butterfly is **Hanno Blue**. The undersides of its wings aren't as bright, so they're camouflaged from predators when they close their wings.




Montserrat Ameivas only live in Montserrat. They're also called Ground Lizards.




Blue Vervain

Red

Red is an important colour for animals and plants. It can signal danger, or be used to attract mates.



Some insects are red, like this **Spotless Ladybird**, to warn birds and other predators not to eat them.



This male **Lesser Antillean Bullfinch** has red markings. The females are brown and grey, and well camouflaged.
